Abstract

This paper proposes a simple method for measuring population diversity with reference to industry category of main and marginal work force in Mumbai City using census data available for 2001 census. According to data, industry category for main as well as well as marginal work force is divided into four categories viz. Cultivators, Agricultural, Household and Others. We propose to study diversity within population and diversity between two strata's of population when one stratum contains Main workers and other strata contains Marginal workers.
